About PA Donor Day

PA Donor Day is a time for all Pennsylvanians to celebrate their power to save and heal lives by signing up as an organ and tissue donor. It's a unifying opportunity to work together to:

- Raise awareness of the critical need for more donors.
- Dispel myths and misconceptions about donation
- Urge family, friends, neighbors, and colleagues to sign up as a donor so that no one on the transplant list dies waiting

The date of PA Donor Day – Friday, August 1 (or 8/1) – highlights the incredible potential of one organ donor to save eight lives! Every Pennsylvanian can be a hero by signing up as a donor, which takes less than a minute.

You can help PA Donor Day 2025 achieve a milestone of having 50% of eligible Pennsylvanians registered as organ and tissue donors. There are lots of easy, impactful ways to participate detailed in this toolkit.

Now in its sixth year, PA Donor Day 2025 aligns in August with National Minority Donor Awareness Month, a major observance to save lives and improve the quality of life in diverse communities by creating a positive culture for organ and tissue donation.

PA Donor Day will bring hope to more than 6,000 children and adults waiting for a life-saving transplant in the commonwealth. The need for more donor heroes is urgent following a decline in Pennsylvanians visiting a DMV and signing up as a donor. Each Pennsylvanian has the power to help! Everyone is encouraged to sign up as a donor regardless of age, health or medical history.

On PA Donor Day, let's spread the word that organ and tissue donation is the ultimate act of kindness and generosity. Most Pennsylvanians support donation but less than half are registered as a donor. Together, we can help every waitlist patient receive a second chance at life.

How To Participate

As a partner of PA Donor Day, there are plenty of ways you can participate and help spread the word about organ and tissue donation in Pennsylvania. To help you get started, we're sharing a few ideas below.

- Send an invitation to your colleagues reminding them of PA Donor Day.
- Look for stories to share within your organization we suspect someone you work with has been touched in some way by organ and tissue donation!
 - As an example, take a look at the incredible stories on DonateLifePA.org, Facebook and Instagram for inspiration.
- Share our pre-drafted social media content and inspirational stories on your organization's socialchannels. Don't forget to tag @DonateLifePennsylvania on Facebook and @DonateLife_PA on Instagram and use #PADonorDay. Also use #NMDAM to celebrate National Minority Donor Awareness Month!
- Send an email about PA Donor Day to your coworkers and friends, or use our pre-drafted one.
- Hang posters about PA Donor Day in high-traffic areas in your workspace.
- Host a virtual PA Donor Day kickoff meeting. Ask employees to dress in blue or green, the colors of organ donation, take a picture and share on social.
- Donate to the Governor Robert P. Casey Memorial Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Trust Fund in honor of PA Donor Day.
- Invite a representative from Gift of Life Donor Program in eastern PA or the Center for Organ Recovery & Education in western PA to come and speak to your organization.
- Send a simple email to your colleagues letting them know about PA Donor Day. Here is a sample:

Every 10 minutes someone in Pennsylvania is told they need a life-saving transplant. With more than 6,000 patients currently on the transplant waiting list, the need for more registered organ and tissue donors is a public health crisis – but it's one that we have the power to change.

We are proud to partner with Donate Life PA (DLPA) as they launch their sixth annual PA Donor Day on August 1, 2025 (8/1) to help raise awareness and drive organ donor registrations. In 2025, we want to hit the milestone of having 50% of eligible Pennsylvanians registered, and we need your help!


